# Information Clause on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for the participants of XXXI FIDE Congress in Katowice

# 1. Data Controller

## 3. Purposes of processing and the legal basis for processing

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6 Section 1 Letter c, e and f of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (general regulation on data protection), GDPR:

- 1. fulfilment of the legal obligation regarding financial settlements in connection with participation in congress;
- 2. the performance of the public task of the university, consisting in particular of the dissemination of scientific and cultural achievements during the congress (Article 11 (1), point 9 of the Act of 20 July 2018. Law on higher education and science);
- 3. the legitimate interest pursued by the university, through the use, including dissemination: of an image or video that is only a detail of the whole and not the main motive of the photograph (without close-ups on the face, i.e. in such a way to show the facts of the congress and not the image or video of the individual persons participating in it), a person widely known concerning the performance of public functions for promotional and informational purposes (art. 81 (2) of the Act of 4.02.1994 on Copyright and Related Rights).

We would like to inform you that during the congress e photographs will be taken and published on the website of the University of Silesia in Katowice to increase scientific visibility.

Providing personal data is necessary to carry out the registration and organisation of the congress. If the data is not provided, it will not be possible to fulfil the purpose mentioned above.

#### 4. Period of storage of personal data

We will keep your personal data for as long as necessary for the processing indicated above.

#### 5. Recipients of data

Personal data of active participants of the Congress (i.e. name and names of co-authors), affiliation, title of the paper, (abstract) may be made public as part of the Congress program, on promotional materials related to the Congress, as well as in any materials informing about the Congress, including the Congress website. Your personal data (image) may be published, through any medium (local and nationwide), including websites administered by the University of Silesia, social media, and in print.

Your data will be transferred to entities providing IT services with whom we have concluded a personal data entrustment agreement regarding the use of the Coffee registration system.

We may transfer your data to external entities, including travel agencies, hotels, insurers, and public authorities or entities authorized to obtain data under applicable laws, e.g. courts, law enforcement agencies, or state institutions when they make a request based on an appropriate legal basis.

## 6. Rights related to the processing of personal data

You have the following rights related to the processing of personal data:

- 1. the right to access your personal data,
- 2. the right to request the correction of your incorrect personal data and to supplement incomplete personal data,
- 3. the right to request your personal data to be deleted,
- 4. the right to request the processing of your personal data to be limited,
- 5. the right to object to the processing of your personal data,
- 6. the right to transfer your personal data,
- 7. the right not to be subject to solely automated decision-making, including profiling,
- 8. the right to file a complaint to the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, i.e. the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data.
